The latest estimates from the U.S Census Bureau demonstrate Hidalgo County residents suffer from one of the highest poverty rates in Texas at 30%. Families living with limited resources may struggle to provide their children the tools to advance academically. One thing all children are affected by no matter their background is fundamental weather.

The Office of the County Judge seeks to encourage emergency preparedness and ease the comprehension of severe weather conditions among elementary children.
