Early meteorological knowledge can help children stay safe and informed by understanding weather development along with promoting proper preparedness. Children are a positive influence in their homes and can successfully deliver the message of emergency preparedness to their families. The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration published a report on January 2021 ranking Texas as the #1 most disaster-prone state in the Country with 1,520 severe weather tabulations. There is no doubt that the comprehension of fundamental weather elements such as the water cycle is crucial for children and will impact their decisions throughout their adult life. MCP Shows will help jumpstart this learning experience by capturing children's attention with entertaining weather material. Weather Wonders with Meteorologist Maggie will provide children with knowledge and science skills to sharpen their understanding of weather including the water cycle.
