Project Summary:

The latest estimates from the U.S Census Bureau demonstrate Hidalgo County residents suffer from one of the highest poverty rates in Texas at 30%. Families living with limited resources may struggle to provide their children the tools to advance academically. One thing all children are affected by no matter their background is fundamental weather.

The Office of the County Judge seeks to encourage emergency preparedness and ease the comprehension of severe weather conditions among elementary children. Many children are scared of thunder and lightning yet they love playing in water puddles and are mesmerized by beautiful rainbows. An early introduction of weather concepts can help children stay safe and confident during an emergency.

Children are positive influencers and can effectively bring an emergency preparedness message home to their loved ones. MCP Shows may inspire children to take joy in learning the water cycle, meteorology, and science thus laying the groundwork to disaster readiness and safety. Meteorologist Maggie leaves lasting impressions with her exquisite storytelling that will impact the children's adult life and actions.
