Attached is the FY 2022 membership dues invoice for Hidalgo County for the Texas Conference of Urban Counties.

The dues formula for FY 2022 remains the same for the fourth consecutive fiscal year – \$3,000 per county and \$0.025 per resident of the county as determined by the 2020 Census published by the US Census Bureau.

Recent legislative action to limit the authority of local elected officials makes collaboration with your peers increasingly important. CUC provides a framework for county officials to discuss public policy matters and help push back on the efforts to consolidate power in Austin. When we develop a unified message for state leaders, our collective impact has a greater impact on policy issues. CUC will continue to provide insights into the legislative process and be a forum to advance the ideal that government closest to the people governs best.
