The 1295 is not needed for Insight as the State of Texas changed the requirements <https://www.ethics.state.tx.us/data/filinginfo/1295Changes.pdf>

We fall under this exemption, as we are publicly traded. Our ticker symbol is NSIT.

The amended law adds to the list of types of contract exempt from the Form 1295 filing requirement. A completed Form 1295 is not required for:

- a sponsored research contract of an institution of higher education;
- an interagency contract of a state agency or an institution of higher education;
- a contract related to health and human services if:
 - the value of the contract cannot be determined at the time the contract is executed; and
 - any qualified vendor is eligible for the contract;
- a contract with a publicly traded business entity, including a wholly owned subsidiary of the business entity;*
- a contract with an electric utility, as that term is defined by Section 31.002.
