**Project Description**

The Bentsen Road Stormwater Project will manage and reduce stormwater for the project area. The project is located approximately ¼ mile south of Highway 107 and will include roadside ditch widening along with a stormwater network with an ultimate outfall into HCDD1 West Main Drain II. Inlets will be placed throughout the project limits along with roadside ditch grading to manage stormwater during and after rain events. Bentsen Road Stormwater Project will provide improvement to the quality of life and reduce flooding in the area.

As per the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds FAQ document, in question 6.15, recipients are able to use ARPA funds for road repairs and upgrades directly related to an eligible stormwater project. Efficient stormwater services directly translate into a healthier community by providing clean water and avoiding potential environmental disasters.
