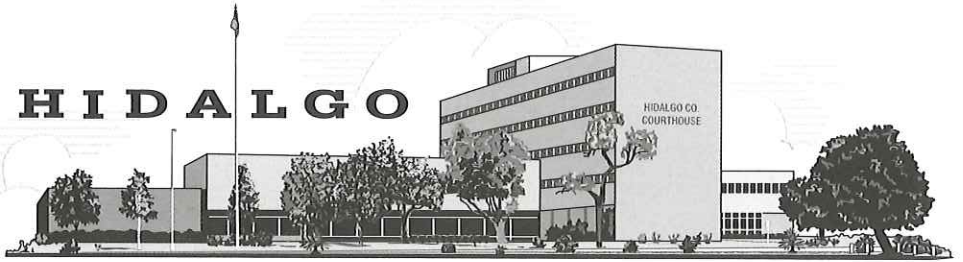

2022-2023 GRANTS AWARDED

The Texas Veterans Commission announced the Fund for Veterans' Assistance grant recipients on May 12, 2022 during their FY22 3rd Quarter Commission Meeting.

For the upcoming grant period (July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023), there were 139 grants awarded, totaling \$31,470,000. 2022-2023 TVC grant recipients are projected to provide direct services to 23,954 veterans, their dependents, and surviving spouses.
