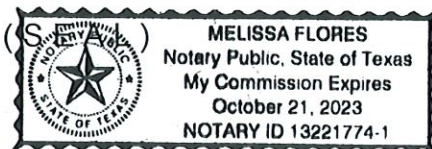

Membership fees are collected annually to ensure the State Bar can continue to fulfill its statutory purposes (Tex. Gov't Code § 81.012). We are sending this notice as required by the State Bar Rules, Article III, Section 6. **While all membership fees were due on June 1, 2022, the State Bar will accept payments, without penalty or suspension, until midnight on August 31, 2022.**

Membership fee payments must be made online using a credit card, debit card, or electronic funds transfer. **To pay your membership dues and legal services fees, please log on to your *My Bar Page* at texasbar.com and select "PAY MEMBERSHIP FEES".** You can also join sections through your *My Bar Page*, and the Supreme Court of Texas encourages all members to contribute \$150 to Access to Justice.

There is no additional fee to pay by electronic funds transfer. However, credit card and debit card payments include a \$5 processing fee. This fee partially offsets transaction fees that the State Bar of Texas is required to pay its credit card processor. All payment data entered on the State Bar website is transferred using industry-standard encryption methods. The Membership Department does not retain credit card, debit card, or bank information.

The State Bar no longer accepts checks for membership fees unless you receive prior authorization due to disability or undue hardship. All other checks will be returned to the sender.
