**Project Description:**

The project will include the installation of Tyler NewWorld software on all computers for use by the Sheriff's Office. The software will be implemented within 12 to 18 months. The software will be hosted by Tyler Technologies. The CAD/RMS client software will need to be installed and configured on all connected computers. Data conversion will need to be completed from the old system to the new environment. The Tyler software will directly integrate with the current court system as well as other law enforcement entities if needed.

The Tyler NewWorld software will increase integration with the court and RMS software platforms allowing for more streamlined data processing. SLFRF funding may be used for administrative needs caused or exacerbated by the pandemic, including technology infrastructure to adapt government operations to the pandemic (e.g., video conferencing software, data, and case management systems)<sup>1</sup>.
