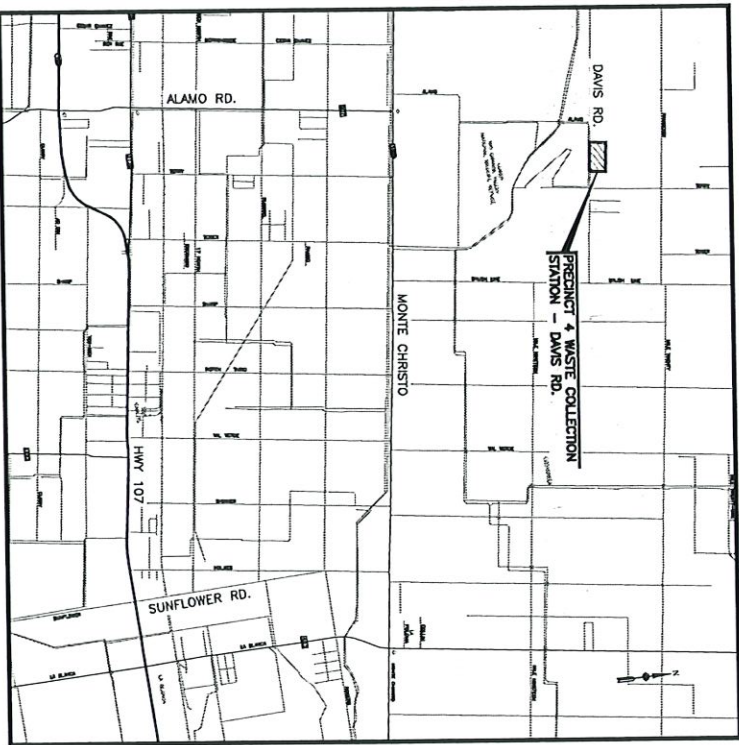
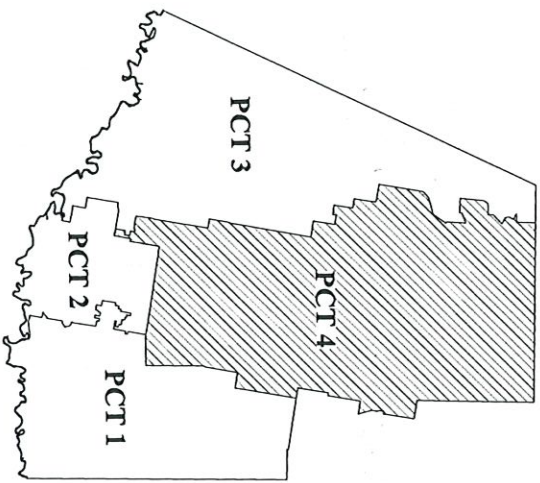
PCT. NO. 4 CITIZEN'S COLLECTION STATION

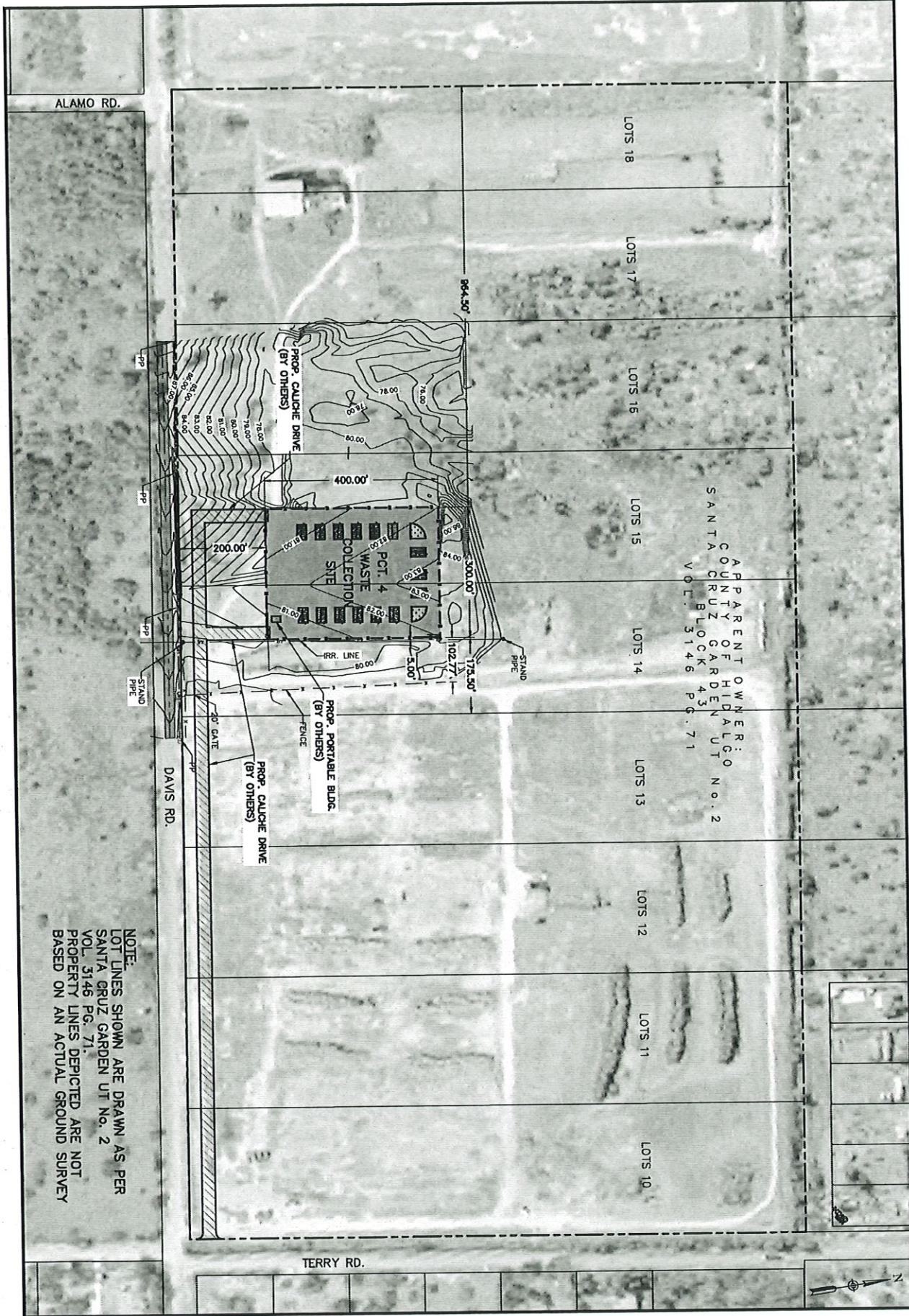

GENERAL NOTES (CONTD.):

- 29. ALL ROAD CROSSINGS SHALL BE REPLACED WITH A MINIMUM OF 8" COMPACTED CALICHE AND 2" HMAc OR LIKE SECTION, WHICHEVER IS GREATER.
- 30. THE DRAINAGE DISTRICT WILL PROVIDE CONTROL POINTS (BENCHMARK AND PROPERTY CORNERS) FOR THE WORK TO BE PERFORMED BY THE CONTRACTOR. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR CONSTRUCTION STAKING, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO HORIZONTAL & VERTICAL GRADIENTS FOR CURB & CUTTER, ROADWAY, STORM DRAIN PIPE, ROADSIDE DITCHES, DRIVEWAY CULVERTS AND DITCH WORK.
- 31. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONNECT PROP. IRRIGATION LINE WITH EXISTING IRRIGATION PIPE IN ACCORDANCE WITH H.C.D. NO SPECIFICATIONS. SUPPORT COLLARS MAY BE USED. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO REPAIR ANY DAMAGE TO THE EXIST. LINE CAUSED BY THIS WORK. ELBOWS AND MISC. FITTINGS SHALL ALSO BE USE TO ACHIEVE A 1.0 FT SEPARATION BETWEEN TOP OF PROP. DRAIN LINE AND BOTTOM OF THE IRRIGATION LINE.
- 32. ELBOW FOR ROP OR HPP BEING PROPOSED AT THE END OF LINES SHALL BE PRE-FABRICATED AND SECURED TO THE PIPE WITH A CONCRETE COLLAR (TYPICAL ON ALL PIPE ELBOW INSTALLATIONS). ELBOW SHALL BE REQUIRED AT ALL LOCATIONS SHOWN ON THE PLANS. THIS SHALL BE CONSIDERED SUBSIDIARY TO THE PROJECT COST AND REFLECTED IN THE UNIT BID PRICES FOR VARIOUS ITEMS LISTED IN THE PROPOSAL. PRE-FABRICATED ELBOWS SHALL BE FIELD CONFIRMED BY THE CONTRACTOR.
- 33. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR IMPROVING ALL EXISTING DRIVEWAYS, CALICHE, DIRT OR ASPHALT DRIVEWAYS SHALL BE REPLACED WITH 3" COMPACTED CALICHE AND 1" AC". CONCRETE DRIVEWAYS SHALL BE REPLACED WITH 4" CONCRETE WITH REINFORCEMENT AS PER DETAILS. THIS SHALL BE CONSIDERED SUBSIDIARY TO THE PROJECT COST REFLECTED IN THE UNIT BID PRICES FOR VARIOUS ITEMS LISTED ON THE PROPOSAL UNLESS STATED OTHERWISE.
- 34. FOR ALL PITS OR QUARRIES, COMPLY WITH THE "TEXAS AGGREGATE QUARRY AND PIT SAFETY ACT".
- 35. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL RELOCATE OR RECONSTRUCT ALL MAIL BOXES TO BE 1' BEHIND BACK OF CURB OR 3' BEHIND EDGE OF PAVEMENT. MAIL BOXES SHALL BE REPLACED TO THE SAME EXISTING CONDITIONS OR BETTER. SAID RELOCATION AND/OR RECONSTRUCTION OF MAIL BOXES SHALL BE CONSIDERED SUBSIDIARY TO THE PROJECT COST AND REFLECTED IN THE UNIT BID PRICES FOR VARIOUS ITEMS LISTED IN THE PROPOSAL.
- 36. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ADJUSTING ALL EXISTING WATER VALVES AND MANHOLES TO MATCH PROPOSED FINISH GRADE OF ROADWAY. CONCRETE COLLARS SHALL BE INSTALLED TO MATCH TOPS WITH PAVEMENT GRADE. THIS WORK SHALL BE INCIDENTAL AND NOT A SEPARATE PAY ITEM UNLESS STATED OTHERWISE.
- 37. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL INSURE A 6" MINIMUM COVER FOR DRIVEWAY CULVERTS. THE RELAYING OR REMOVAL OF DRIVEWAY PIPE CULVERTS SHALL BE CONSIDERED SUBSIDIARY TO THE PROJECT COST REFLECTED IN THE UNIT BID PRICES FOR VARIOUS ITEMS LISTED ON THE PROPOSAL UNLESS STATED OTHERWISE.
- 38. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE REPLACEMENT/RELOCATION OF ALL REGULATORY SIGNS REMOVED DUE TO CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS WITH THE SAME SIGN ON FIXED SUPPORT(S) IMMEDIATELY UPON ITS REMOVAL. APPROVAL BY THE ENGINEER IS NECESSARY BEFORE REMOVING ANY REGULATORY ROADWAY SIGN(S). FLAGGERS ARE REQUIRED TO DIRECT TRAFFIC DURING SIGN REMOVAL. INTERMEDIATE DOWN TIME RELOCATION OF ANY DIRECTIONAL SIGN ASSEMBLIES REMOVED DURING CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS IMMEDIATELY UPON THEIR REMOVAL IS REQUIRED. THESE SIGNS SHALL BE RELOCATED TO A LOCATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LATEST VERSION OF THE TEXAS MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES". IN NO CASE WILL A SIGN BE REMOVED WITHOUT A REPLACEMENT SIGN AND SUPPORT(S) BEING READILY AVAILABLE AND A LOCATION ESTABLISHED. REMOVAL AND RELOCATION OF THESE SIGNS WILL NOT BE PAID FOR DIRECTLY, BUT SHALL BE CONSIDERED SUBSIDIARY TO THE PROJECT COST REFLECTED IN THE UNIT BID PRICES FOR VARIOUS ITEMS LISTED ON THE PROPOSAL.
- 39. ALL CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS SHALL BE CONDUCTED TO PROVIDE THE LEAST POSSIBLE INTERFERENCE TO TRAFFIC AS PROVIDED FOR IN THE SPECIFICATIONS, TxDOT STANDARDS, TEXAS M.U.T.C.D. AND/OR AS DIRECTED. ALL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES SHALL CONFORM TO THE CURRENT EDITION OF THE TEXAS MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES".
- 40. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ABANDON AND CAP ANY PORTION OF PIPE LINE (STORM, IRRIGATION, ETC.) FOUND WITHIN THE PROPOSED PIPE TRENCH, AT THE ENGINEERS REQUEST. SOLID WASTE COLLECTION/RECOVERY CENTER STATION
RULES & GUIDELINES

The Commissioners' Court of Hidalgo County has ordered a Solid Waste Disposal program and has adopted these Solid Waste Citizen Collection/Recovery Center Station Rules and Guidelines in order to safeguard the public health; to ensure the safety of county employees; to ensure the safe and efficient operation of the collection/recovery center stations; to ensure that only residential waste from rural and unincorporated area county residents is disposed of at the collection/recovery center stations and to control and monitor proper access to the collection/recovery center stations.

Illegally dumped trash is a huge problem for our communities impacting water flow on our drainage systems, waterways and serve as breeding grounds for rodents and dangerous mosquitos that carry harmful diseases. As per Health and Safety Section 365.012, a person commits an offense and may be convicted of illegal dumping, if the person disposes, allows, receives, transports, or permits the disposal of solid waste at a place that is not an approved solid waste disposal site. Not only does it contaminate your community, but it also carries a fine and jail time if convicted.

GENERAL SOLID WASTE COLLECTION/RECOVERY CENTER STATION RULES

- The Solid Waste Collection/Recovery Center Stations will accept authorized solid waste generated by the rural and unincorporated resident living within Hidalgo County as described under these rules
- Rural boundaries are areas not within city limits.
- All trash must be bagged
- The operator of any vehicle transporting authorized solid waste to the collection/recovery center station shall, as condition of use, present evidence and/or answer any reasonable questions concerning the nature and place of origin of that material as the sanitation attendant in charge may request.
- The Attendant in Charge shall be obeyed at all times and all authorized solid wastes must be deposited in appropriate designated areas and in accordance with the collection/recovery center station operator's instructions.
- The County of Hidalgo reserves the right to reject any solid wastes, which it considers to be detrimental to the operation of the collection/recovery center station, or contrary to these rules.
- The collection/recovery center stations will only admit vehicles with a valid collection/recovery center station permit affixed on the vehicle windshield.
- At the time of submitting an application to obtain a permit, the applicant shall provide proof of a valid rural and unincorporated service eligibility address such as an electric bill, water bill, natural gas bill, telephone bill, cable bill or driver's license that specifically identifies the service address you are seeking a solid waste permit for.
- Permits will be issued only to those applicants who comply with these rules. The ownership of real property is not the determining factor as to who may receive a permit.
- During inclement weather or other emergency conditions, the transfer stations may be closed. Please contact your precinct office via phone, website or social media to confirm availability.

PROHIBITED CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOR

Disposal of solid waste at any of the Hidalgo County Solid Waste Citizen Collection/Recovery Center Stations without a valid solid waste permit properly affixed to the vehicle windshield is a violation of established rules and guidelines and may result in civil penalties. Transfer Station permit holders and their passengers are required to and will conduct themselves in a civil manner. Rude, offensive, disorderly, obscene, slanderous, defamatory, disruptive and profane language or violent statements toward other visitants and county sanitation/recovery center station employees will not be tolerated. Courteous conduct and behavior is required at all times.

Complaints will be reported to law enforcement personnel and your solid waste permit may be denied.

PERMITS

Vehicles Permits

A permit is required for use of all Hidalgo County Solid Waste Citizen Collection/Recovery Center Stations. Permits must prominently be affixed on the user's vehicle windshield and must be visible when within the collection/recovery center station. All vehicles entering the collection/recovery center station must display a valid permit issued to that specific vehicle and vehicle owner. All permits MUST have a permit application filled out in full before a permit is issued. The collection/recovery center station permits are not valid until affixed to the permitted vehicle. Permit applications and renewals may be obtained at the designated Precinct Offices.

- ONLY Hidalgo County rural and unincorporated area residents will qualify for the permit.
- All users are required to obtain a permit prior to use of the collection station/recovery center.
- Collection station/recovery center permits are not transferable.
- Vehicle permit will cost \$25 and will be valid for ninety (90) days from the date of purchase.
- Additional vehicle permits may be obtained at the same cost of \$25 for ninety (90) days. (ex: one vehicle, one permit = \$25. Two vehicles, two permits = \$50).
- Proof of Hidalgo County rural and unincorporated residency address is required. Eligible forms include an electric bill, water bill, natural gas bill, telephone bill or driver's license that specifically identifies the permit holder to the service address you are seeking a solid waste permit for. Limit one (1) vehicle per permit.
- Permit applications and renewals may be obtained at the designated Precinct Offices.

Vehicle Permit with Double Axle Trailer

A permit authorizing the use of a double axle trailer is required for use of all Hidalgo County Solid Waste Citizen Collection/Recovery Center Stations. Permits must be prominently affixed on the user's vehicle windshield and must be visible when entering the collection/recovery center station. All vehicles entering the collection station/recovery center with a double-axle trailer must display a valid double-axle trailer permit issued to that specific vehicle and vehicle owner. All double-axle permits MUST have a permit application filed out in full before a permit is issued. Double-axle trailer permits are not valid until affixed to the permitted vehicle. Double-axle trailer permit applications may be obtained at the designated Precinct Offices. ONLY Hidalgo County rural and unincorporated area residents will qualify for the double-axle trailer permit.

- All users are required to obtain a permit prior to use of the collection/recovery center station.
- The collection/recovery center station double-axle trailer permit is not transferable.
- A double-axle trailer permit will cost \$50 and will be good for ninety (90) days from the date of purchase.

- Rural residents will be screened to ensure they possess a valid permit for the vehicle present.
- Disposal of solid waste will be limited to once per day per vehicle.
- Incoming trash will be visually inspected to deter unauthorized waste.
- No vehicle will be allowed entry to the collection/recovery center station without a valid permit affixed on the authorized vehicle windshield or with a valid single one-time use permit.
- All one-time single use permits (vehicle or double-axle trailer) will be collected upon use.
- Items containing refrigerants will only be accepted if freon has been removed.
- Frequency of the person's use of the collection/recovery center stations will be closely monitored to ensure compliance of set rules.

HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS
COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER

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- The collection/recovery center stations are self-service. Solid waste personnel are NOT authorized to assist in unloading any items for disposal and can only monitor to ensure safety.

AUTHORIZED SOLID WASTE

Residential Waste

- Residential waste includes normal household refuse/garbage (paper, plastics, cans, food and vegetable scraps)
- All household trash must be bagged

Tires

- Limit four (4) passenger and light truck tires per month from rural unincorporated residential customers.

Brush & Yard Waste at Brush Collection Sites

- Leaves, grass clippings, tree trimmings and brush.
- Each precinct will have a designated collection/recovery center station that will allow brush or yard waste.
- Brush should be cut in 3 to 4 foot lengths and securely tied.

Bulky Items

- No more than 2 appliances per visit
- Furniture: sofas, love seats, chairs, tables, desks, shelves, mattress/box springs, bed frames, and dressers.
- Appliances: washers, dryers, stoves, refrigerators w/o freon, water heaters, ovens and other electronics.
- Freon must be removed from any refrigerated items prior to bringing items to the recovery center.
- Toilets, sinks, tubs, doors and ladders.
- Exercise equipment, bicycles, lawnmowers, carpets, padding(one room only and must be rolled and tied)
- Outdoor patio furniture, tables and bbq grills w/o propane tank and kiddie pools

Scrap Metal

- Metal that can be sold as scrap. Must be disposed on the authorized bins

NON-AUTHORIZED SOLID WASTE

Bulky Items

- Outdoor play systems

Commercial waste

- Contractor or commercial waste/building materials.
- Demolition waste such as brick, concrete, shingles, wood, gypsum, and sheet rock.

Automotive Parts

- Car batteries, fenders, vehicle doors, body and frame parts, engines, transmissions; as these items should be disposed of in a salvage yard.
- Commercial truck/tractor tires

HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS
COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER

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Scrap Metal - Non Authorized

- Any salvage metal made of galvanized or other non-recyclable metal products will not be allowed for disposal. (Ex: Chain link fencing, wiring or similar metals)

Hazardous waste

- Pesticides, fertilizers, herbicides, chemicals and cleaners
- Paint thinners, toxins, poisons, asbestos, and petroleum products such as gas, oil and kerosene
- Drums, Paint Cans, liquids or solvents of any kinds
- Items with Freon (Refrigerators, freezers, A/C Units)
- Dead animals.

ALLOWABLE VEHICLES

- Passenger cars including station wagons and sport utility vehicles, vans, pick-up trucks and small single axle utility trailers not to exceed 5' x 8' with permit or valid one-time single use permit.
- Double axle utility trailers not to exceed 16'L x 6 1/2 W x 1 1/2 H with valid permit or one-time single use permit.

VEHICLES NOT ALLOWED

- Dump trucks, Non-Governmental Box Trucks, Rack Body Trucks, Large Trailers exceeding authorized dimensions and large trucks (those with a cargo area exceeding manufacturer's full size pick-up truck body).
- Double axle trailers will not be accepted unless valid permit or single use one time permit is issued and displayed
- No ATV's, UTV's or Off Road motorized vehicles.

LOCAL DECLARED STATE OF DISASTER EVENTS

- The Solid Waste Citizen Collection Station Rules and Guidelines may be modified or waived upon approval by the local government only after a Local State of Disaster has been declared by Hidalgo County .

NOTICE: DISPOSING OR ALLOWING OR PERMITTING THE DISPOSAL OF LITER OR OTHER SOLID WASTE AT A PLACE THAT IS NOT AN APPROVED DISPOSAL FACILITY OR ; RECEIVING LITTER OR OTHER SOLID WASTE FOR DISPOSAL AT A PLACE THAT IS NOT AN APPROVED DISPOSAL FACILITY OR; TRANSPORTING LITTER OR OTHER SOLID WASTE TO A PLACE THAT IS NOT AN APPROVED FACILITY FOR DISPOSAL OR; DISPOSING SOLID WASTE OR LITTER IN A DUMPSTER THAT IS CONTROLLED BY SOMEONE ELSE WITHOUT PERMISSION, IS A VIOLATION OF LAW AND OFFENDERS SHALL BE PROSECUTED(Sub. Ch. B, Ch. 365 Health & SafetyCode).
