Good Afternoon Planning Partners,

On Thursday December 14th, the US Department of Transportation released the 2023 Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity Grant otherwise known as the RAISE Grant Program application Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO). Applications are due by 11:59PM EST on February 28th, 2023.

Attached to this email you will all find a copy of the full notice of funding opportunity, and we have also dropped a link below where you can find more resources regarding the application.

Here are some key facts about this year's RAISE applications:

- Minimum Grant Size
 - \$5 Million in Urban Areas
 - \$1 Million in Rural Areas
- Maximum Grant Size
 - Grants may not be greater than \$25 Million.
- Fiscal Year 2023 RAISE grant funds are available for obligation only through September 30th, 2027
- Eligible Applicants
 - States and the District of Columbia
 - Any territory of the United States
 - A unit of local government
 - A public agency or publicly chartered authority established by one or more States
 - A special purpose district or public authority with a transportation function; including a port authority
 - A Federally recognized Indian Tribe or consortium of Indian Tribes
 - A transit agency
 - A multi-state or multijurisdictional group of entities that are separately eligible.
- Federal Share of a project shall not exceed 80% unless the project is located in a rural area, a historically disadvantaged community (HDC), or an area of persistent poverty (APP).
