**RESOLUTION AND ORDER
PERTAINING TO NAMING EASTSIDE SOCCER PARK**

WHEREAS, the Hidalgo County Commissioners Court (the "Commissioners Court") through Precinct 4, accepted a park donation for the development of Pueblo De Palmas Park as recorded in Document Number 3126294, Hidalgo County Official Records on July 1, 2020, to increase the quality of public recreation facilities and resources available to the people of central Hidalgo County; and

WHEREAS, Pueblo De Palmas Park is a 11.697 Tract of Land being a portion out of Pueblo De Palmas Phase 22 and Pueblo De Palmas Phase 23, and a part or portion out of Lots 21, 25 and 29 amended map of Santa Cruz Gardens Unit No. 2, according to the plat thereof recorded in Volume 8, Pages 28 and 29, Hidalgo County Map Records, and is within the jurisdiction of Hidalgo County Precinct 4 located at the intersection of Mile 19 North and Cesar Chavez Road; and

WHEREAS, Commissioners Court has found a public purpose in providing, operating, and maintaining parks, playgrounds, and recreation for the public health and welfare; and

WHEREAS, Pueblo De Palmas Park is currently under construction and being developed that include amenities for the use of the public; and

WHEREAS, Pueblo De Palmas Park is located in the eastern jurisdiction of Hidalgo County Precinct 4, the County wishes to more appropriately rename this park for the public not only for those who reside or have an interest in the Pueblo De Palmas Subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, As such, the County of Hidalgo wishes to rename Pueblo De Palmas Park to Eastside Soccer Park.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

1. The Commissioners Court hereby renames the Park from Pueblo De Palmas Park to Eastside Soccer Park.
2. The Commissioners Court authorizes the County to execute the appropriate documents approving this name change upon approval of substantial completion of this project.
3. Any prior Resolution and Order of the Commissioner Court in conflict with the provisions contained in this Resolution and Order are hereby replaced and revoked.
4. Should any part of this Resolution and Order be held invalid for any reason, the remainder shall not be affected thereby, and such remaining portions are hereby declared to be severable.
5. This Resolution and Order shall take effect immediately from and after it is passed and is duly resolved and ordered.
