

*Proclamation in honor of the Edinburg High School Bobcat
Cheerleaders on winning the National Cheerleaders Association
High School National Championship*

Whereas the Edinburg High School Bobcat Cheerleaders were invited to compete at The National Cheerleaders Association's High School National Championship Competition in Dallas, Texas held on January 21 through January 23, 2023, to defend their 2022 National Championship Title; and

Whereas the Bobcat Cheerleaders' hard work, positive attitude, confidence, courage, discipline, concentration, intelligence and relentlessness also contributed to their invitation to National's; and

Whereas the Edinburg High School Bobcat Cheerleaders competed among some of the most talented and competitive High School Cheerleading squads from across the nation in the Intermediate Large Varsity Performance Division; and

Whereas after two days of fierce competition, the Bobcat Cheerleaders' performance earned them a final score of 99.8. This is the highest score in the history of the school's program. This exceptional score was enough to make the Edinburg High School Bobcat Cheerleaders the 2023 National Cheerleaders Association's High School National Championships retaining their crown from the previous year; and

Whereas in addition to winning the National Champion Title, the EHS Bobcat Cheerleaders also received awards for superior showmanship, best stunts, Hit Zero, Herkie High Point Champion and the highest score in the entire competition. In addition, this is the first EHS all-girl team to receive a National Championship Title; and

Whereas the County of Hidalgo is extremely proud of these young ladies as they continue the tradition of excellence at Edinburg High School by once again bringing back the National Championship to the County of Hidalgo and the City of Edinburg

Now therefore, be it proclaimed that the Hidalgo County Commissioners Court hereby honors the Edinburg High School Bobcat Cheerleaders for continuing the history of pride and tradition after winning their ninth consecutive National High School Championship
