Thank you Karen for the information. I have some additional questions if you may be able to help with:

-Is there a survival clause that transitions the previous Coop Contract # [020772513] to the new Coop Contract # [190402]? **Contract 2072513 expired in July 2016. Then contract 2072816 was awarded and it expired in July 2019. Then contract 190402 was awarded and will be valid until July 2024.**

How many years after contract expiration is the survival clause effective? **Please see response to this question below. This is the response from our legal team:**

Please feel free to forward this email to the inquiring Member. If a purchase is made while the TIPS Contract is active, the survival clause asserts that the terms of the TIPS contract apply to that purchase even after the TIPS contract expires. For example, if they buy a pen while the contract is active, the TIPS terms apply to that purchase. If they buy a 15-year contract with a provider while the TIPS Contract is active, the TIPS terms apply to that purchase for the duration of the purchased services, even if they exceed the expiration of the TIPS Contract.

-Is there additional steps required when the original 60 month term expires and we continue on a month to month basis?
There is nothing additional required on our end. Enterprise Fleet Management is an Automated vendor and reports TIPS purchases to us.
