

*Resolution and Order Pertaining to Renaming the
San Carlos Community Resource Center to the
Lydia Maldonado Precinct 4 Whole Life Complex*

- Whereas* the property and facilities where the San Carlos Community Resource Center sits on is owned by the County of Hidalgo and is within the jurisdiction of Precinct 4. The San Carlos Community Resource Center lies on multiple lots of Block 9, Original Townsite of San Carlos, Hidalgo County, Texas, as recorded in Volume 5 Pages 1 and 2, Map Records, Hidalgo County, Texas, Hidalgo and as described in “Exhibit A”; and
- Whereas* the San Carlos Community Resource Center provides multiple services to the constituents of the rural area including, but not limited to, medical, educational, and wellness services; and
- Whereas* Commissioners Court previously approved funding for significant improvements to these centers and has found a continued public purpose in providing, operating, expanding and maintaining playgrounds, education, recreation, and health services for the public’s well-being; and
- Whereas* the San Carlos Community Resource Center houses a Head Start School, Area Health Education Center (AHEC) for adults and pediatrics, Women, Infant, and Children Clinic, and a Nuestra Clinica Del Valle; and
- Whereas* the County wishes to honor an individual who has provided decades of community services to the constituents of San Carlos: Mrs. Lydia Maldonado; and
- Whereas* Mrs. Lydia Maldonado was born on February 2, 1942, to the late Julian Rodriguez and Maria Diaz. Mrs. Maldonado was happily married to the late Adan Maldonado. Together, they were blessed with five beautiful children: Gloria Lozano, Arnold Maldonado, Adan Maldonado, Jr., Michelle Briseno, and Alberto Maldonado. Mrs. Maldonado is also the proud grandparent to fourteen grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren; and
- Whereas* at an early age, Mrs. Maldonado’s strong faith lead her to Saint Joseph the Worker Catholic Church in San Carlos, Texas, as a parishioner. For decades, Mrs. Maldonado has devoted herself to the church and the public by serving in many capacities. Mrs. Maldonado has and continues to serve on the church finance committee, organizes fund raisers, and coordinates the church’s annual festival; and
- Whereas* Mrs. Maldonado also served on the Saint Joseph School Board in Edinburg, Texas, while her children attended this school; and
- Whereas* Mrs. Maldonado has spent countless days and hours volunteering her time at the San Carlos Community Resource Center. If there are ever any food drives, clothing drives, or events handing out turkeys during the holidays to families in need, Mrs. Maldonado can always be relied upon to organize these events; and
- Whereas* due to her unselfish efforts and being a pioneer for the Community of San Carlos, Texas, the County of Hidalgo wishes to rename the San Carlos Community Resource Center to the Lydia Maldonado Precinct 4 Whole Life Complex located in San Carlos, Texas.

Now therefore, be it resolved and ordered by the Hidalgo County Commissioners Court that:

1. The Commissioners Court hereby renames the San Carlos Community Resource Center to the Lydia Maldonado Precinct 4 Whole Life Complex to recognize her decades of community service.
2. Any prior Resolution and Order of the Commissioners Court in conflict with the provisions contained in this Resolution and Order are hereby replaced and revoked.
3. Should any part of this Resolution and Order be held invalid for any reason, the remainder shall not be affected thereby, and such remaining portions are hereby declared to be severable.
4. This Resolution and Order shall take effect immediately from and after it is passed and is duly resolved and ordered.
