Dear Sheriff Guerra,

I am pleased to inform you that our request to the Commission on State Emergency Communications (CSEC) on the Regional Planning Commission Plan Amendment: Request for Use of Revenue was APPROVED after our departure from CSEC.

Health and Safety Code § 771.0751, authorizes the Regional Planning Commissions (RPCs) to use allocated 9-1-1 fees and equalization surcharge for eligible expenditures attributable to (1) designing 9-1-1 systems; or (2) obtaining and maintaining equipment and personnel to establish and operate a public safety answering point/9-1-1 Dispatch Center. As you are aware, upon our departure from CSEC and inauguration of our Rio Grande Valley Emergency Communication District - RGV9-1-1 in August 2021, an opportunity to maximize our funding by securing the remaining funds from the FY2019/2020 Biennium was presented. After our closeout and final reconciliation with CSEC and payments related to the new digital 9-1-1 system, the total balance was \$1.7 million of which has been equally divided between the 16 PSAPs.

Enclosed is a check in the amount of \$110,134.32. As per the Texas Administration Code funding guidelines authorize the use of these funds for the enhancement of 9-1-1 systems and telecommunicator salaries. We ask that the check be processed accordingly pursuant to disbursement of these allowable expenditures. This allocation will be the final installment of payments under CSEC.
