STIC provides for community education and training committees.

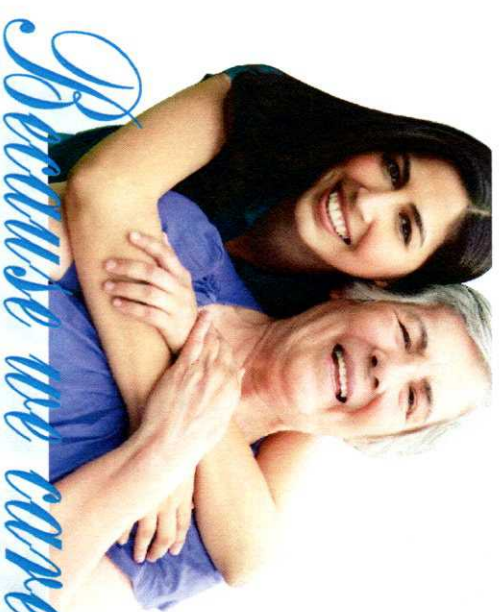
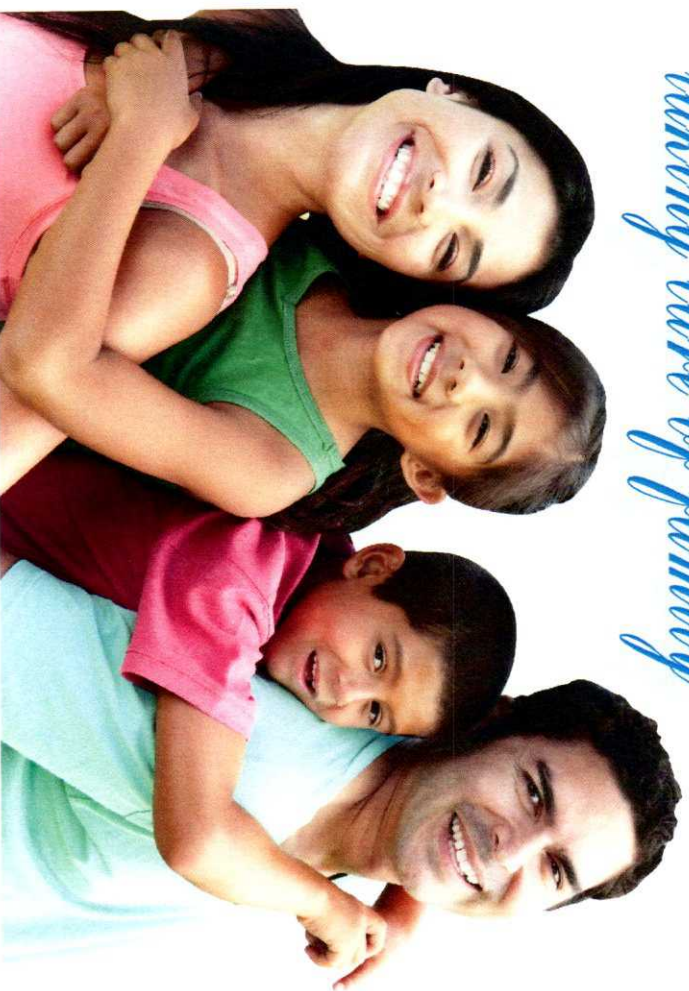
STIC provides current information on statistics, immunization data.
