The Hidalgo County Precinct 2 ToGive International Community Development Project aims to provide a grant to ToGive International, a nonprofit fine arts educational organization primarily located at 2500 Dicker Rd., Suite C Hidalgo, Texas 78557. This project will relieve the negative impacts of the COVID-19 public health emergency on the communities this organization serves. ToGive International has faced challenges due to the COVID-19 public health emergency, including increased demand for services and changing operational needs.

Fine arts curriculums are an essential component of human development, especially when students' emotional health is at risk. Students are motivated to become self-driven, empowered individuals capable of possessing the emotional intelligence necessary to make critical decisions by providing these services. By providing this assistance, ToGive International will continue serving hundreds of students that otherwise can't have the opportunity to continue enrolling in their programs, especially those living near and around Qualified Census Tracts (QCT).

Community Need Assessment

The purpose of the Hidalgo County Precinct 2 ToGive International Community Development Project is congruent with the objectives of the Hidalgo County American Rescue Plan Act, which is to support nonprofit organizations and provide assistance to help mitigate the impacts of the COVID-19 public health emergency, especially to underserved and low- to- mid-income communities.
