High School 2024 National Championship*

*Whereas* the Edinburg High School (EHS) Bobcat Cheerleaders were invited to compete at the National Cheerleaders Association’s High School National Championship Competition in Dallas, Texas held on January 19-21, 2024, to defend their 2023 National Championship Title; and

*Whereas* the Edinburg High School Bobcat Cheerleaders competed amongst some of the most talented and competitive high school cheerleading squads from across the nation in the Intermediate Large Varsity Performance Division; and

*Whereas* the 2024 Bobcat cheerleading squad is under the direction of Eva Guerra, head coach; Monika Luna, assistant coach; Eric Rodriguez, choreographer; and Dominic Pena, principal; and

*Whereas* Hidalgo County is extremely proud of this group of individuals as they continue the tradition of excellence at Edinburg High School by bringing back their historic 10th Consecutive National Championship trophy to Edinburg High School, home of the Bobcats.

*Now, therefore, be it proclaimed* that the Hidalgo County Commissioners Court hereby congratulates the Edinburg High School Bobcat Cheerleaders for winning the 2024 National Cheerleaders Association National High School Championship and wishes them the best of luck on bringing back the National Championship to Edinburg in 2025.
