The Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority (MVCPA) met on March 28th, 2024, and issued an FY2024 SB 224 Catalytic Converter Grant Award to the Hidalgo County in the amount of \$402,473. Additional Instructions

Your jurisdiction is able to add additional funding needs by adjusting the total amounts in the budget support tables.

Once the grantee has made the revisions in the Negotiation document edit link or discussed the required changes with MVCPA there are two options to proceed:

Option 1: The Authorized Official can easily submit the revised application through the GMTS system and the MVCPA will send a SGA. You do not need to contact us if you do option 1, however we will review the revised application before submitted by the Authorized Official if you would like us to.

Option 2: The Grantee agency staff will make changes in the application and save the revised application under the CC Negotiation link. Once all changes have been saved send an email to GrantsMVCPA@txdmv.gov to let us know that you have saved your application and want to go through option 2. MVCPA staff will review the revised application and ensure required changes are reflected. The MVCPA will issue the SGA and use the saved application as the attachment. This allows the grantee to present the revised application and the SGA in one step to their jurisdiction. MVCPA locks the revised application once it and the SGA has been emailed. Only the submit button will be active for your Authorized Official to submit the application. If the agency needs to make changes, you will need to email GrantsMVCPA@txdmv.gov and ask for it to be reopened.
