Good afternoon Mr. Garza,

The MOU that I provided is for enhanced cooperation between the Sheriff's Officer and South Texas College. The MOU request is stemming from Texas Administrative Code 215.3 which states that a Law Enforcement Training Provider shall submit "documentation of any contract an academy may have as co sponsor with law enforcement agencies and other entities to conduct continuing education classes"

Due to South Texas College now having a police academy license from TCOLE they are required to maintain an agreement with an agency to utilize their shooting range due to them not having one at this time.

We currently have an MOU with South Texas College to utilize their skills pad for our Emergency Vehicle Operator Course (EVOC).
