Request for Applications: Wastewater Surveillance Mentorship Program 2025 Cohort

NACCHO, with support from the CDC, is currently seeking applications for twelve mentee sites and six mentor sites to participate in the 2025 Wastewater Surveillance Mentorship Program. Local health departments (LHDs) with demonstrated experience in utilizing wastewater surveillance will be matched with LHDs in the early stages of developing a wastewater surveillance program that are looking for guidance, tools, and resources to meet their community's needs. Selected mentee sites will receive funding in the amount of up to \$20,000 each, and selected mentor sites will receive up to \$25,000. Applications and all supporting materials must be submitted through [OpenWater](#) no later than **11:59 PM ET on Friday, December 6, 2024**. There will be an *optional* informational webinar on November 18 at 1:00 PM ET to provide an overview of the RFA and answer any questions for potential applicants.
