Phase I & II



Allocation Overview- Phase II

Due to the March 27, 2025, Severe Weather and Flood Event, the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs allocated \$500,000.00 to support recovery efforts.

- \$250,000.00 – Direct assistance in the form of gift cards, \$500 per household. (Serving 500 households).
- \$250,000.00 – Replacement of essential household appliances lost or damaged during the flood. Essential appliances include refrigerators, stoves, and water heaters.



Disaster Recovery Distributions

Rapid Response

Phase 1-HCCSA CSBG Funding

Household: 445

Individual Count: 1,435

Expenditures: \$257,050

Phase 2-Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs Funding

A total of 964 households with an individual count of 3,142 received an allocation of \$500 in gift cards to begin and continue the recovery process totaling \$513,170.00.

Household: 519

Individual Count: 1,707

Expenditures: \$256,120



Phase II Appliance Distribution Summary

The following appliances were distributed under Phase II using the \$250,000 appliance allocation:

- Electric Stove 91
- Electric Stove Installation Kits 91
- Gas Stove 71
- Installation Kit for Gas Stove 71
- Refrigerator 189
- Water Heater (Electric) 108
- Installation Kit for Water Heater (Electric) 108
