Dear Hidalgo County,

I am writing this letter to breakdown the process of disposing of the 8-Liner units on your facility and to inform you that we are taking the proper steps to ensure that there will be no harm to the environment during the disposal of these units. We are going to take the unit apart for recycling. The mercury switches will be removed and sent to ELVS for recycling. The units will then be loaded up and transported to the Republic facility in Edinburg, Tx. There they will separate the metals for recycling as well as the glass components. The wooden frame will then be sent to the landfill for disposal. In summary, the hazardous mercury will be recycled as well as the metal and glass. The only part of the machine that will go to the landfill is the non haz wood. There is no risk of harm to the environment.
