FY2026 Bullet-Resistant Components for Law Enforcement Vehicles Resolution

WHEREAS, The Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Hidalgo County, Texas that the FY2026 Bullet-Resistant Components for Law Enforcement Vehicles Grant be operated for the period of March 01st, 2026 to February 28th, 2027

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court understands that there is no matching fund requirement for the said project; and

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Commissioners' County agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, Hidalgo County assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court designates the Hidalgo County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.
