- observed 2 piles of burnt trash on the roadway on Dillon Road.
- Deputy D. Salinas recieved a phone call from Pct.4 Commissionars Office Irais Chiu Administrative Assistant II
- were notified by Irais that the camera that was placed North of Benito Ramirez Rd and Alamo Rd (dirt road) had been stolen.
- along with Deputy D. Salinas went out to the site and observed that the tires where the camera was hidden were still there, but the camera and the surveillane equipment was no where to be found.
- sorted through the brush, and did not find the camera, nor the surveillane equipment.
- then provided an extra patrol but did not find any suspicious vehicles.
- provided a case number, photographs, GPS coordinates and emailed them to Velinda Reyes from the Hidalgo County Commissioners Office Pct.-4 for further investigation.

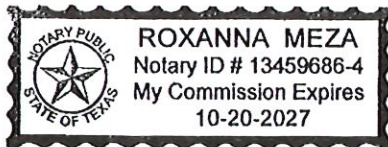
