**AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE
COUNTY OF HIDALGO, TEXAS AND THE ALTACAIR FOUNDATION**

This **AMENDMENT** to the Memorandum of Understanding is made this 14th day of April, **2026**, by and between and the **COUNTY OF HIDALGO, TEXAS** hereinafter referred to as (“**COUNTY**”) and **ALTACAIR FOUNDATION** (“**ALTA**”).

WHEREAS, on or about January 27, 2026, **COUNTY** and **ALTA** entered into an **AGREEMENT** to collaborate the shared goal of providing social and health care services to underserved communities in rural areas of the County; and

WHEREAS, **COUNTY** and **ALTA** desire to amend the **AGREEMENT** related provisions and intention to comply with the same;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the terms and provisions set forth herein, for good valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, **COUNTY** and **ALTA** hereby agree to the following amendment to the **AGREEMENT**.

1. Paragraph “1.” of the **MOU** is hereby amended, modified and/or replaced as follows:

“1. The County agrees to provide **ALTA CAIR** a lump sum in the total amount of up to **ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$100,000.00)** to afford necessary expenses related to establishing partnerships, facilitating collaborative efforts, and the provision of essential and compelling day-to-day social and health care services to rural residents of the County of Hidalgo.”

2. Except as modified herein, all terms and conditions of the **Agreement**, as amended, remain in full force and in effect. **COUNTY** and **ALTA** ratify and confirm the terms and provisions of the **Agreement** as amended herein.
