

SB-8 Sheriff Immigration Enforcement Grant

WHEREAS, The Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Hidalgo County, that the SB-8 Sheriff Immigration Enforcement Grant be operated.

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Comptroller's Office funds Hidalgo County assures that the funds will be returned to the Comptroller's Office in full.

WHEREAS, The Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court designates, The Hidalgo County Sheriff as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

WHEREAS, The Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court may not reduce the appropriation to the Hidalgo County Sheriff's Office in response to receiving the SB-8 Sheriff Immigration Enforcement Grant.

WHEREAS, The Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court designates The Hidalgo County Auditor as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved that the Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court approves submission of the grant application for the SB-8 Sheriff Immigration Enforcement Grant to the Texas Comptroller Office.
