How We Fund

Category	Description
By Invitation Only	For targeted funding opportunities, including “out of cycle” time sensitive initiatives.
Call for Proposals	Open to eligible entities through the Foundant system for various grant types.
Natural Disaster & Public Health Emergency	Designated for crises declared by state or federal authorities or determined by the Board.

What We Fund

Grant Type	Definition
Operating	Supports the essential functions needed to run your organization, including administration and operations.
Program	Supports the direct delivery of a defined program with clear goals, activities, and outcomes to your community.
Capital	Supports physical improvements such as equipment, construction, or facility upgrades.
Collaborative	Supports coordinated efforts between organizations working together on a shared initiative.
Planning	Supports early-stage project development, including research, design, and partnership building.

2027 Funding Framework

Grant Type	Funding Criteria	Maximum Award
Operating	20% of Organizational Budget	\$100,000
Program	30% of Organizational Budget	\$150,000
Capital	30% of Organizational Budget	\$150,000
Collaborative	1 Lead applicant + 1 or more partners	\$150,000
Planning	Early-stage development; requires 2 key stakeholders	\$20,000

Example: Organization with a \$250,000 Organizational Budget

Grant Type	Funding Criteria	Maximum Award
Operating	20% of Organizational Budget	\$50,000
Program	30% of Organizational Budget	\$75,000
Capital	30% of Organizational Budget	\$75,000
Collaborative	1 Lead applicant + 1 or more partners	\$150,000
Planning	Early-stage development; requires 2 key stakeholders	\$20,000

Guidelines

- Grants Awarded for a Maximum of 12 Months
- Grant Requests as per 2027 Grant Guidelines
- Fringe benefits are capped at 27%.
- A 15% indirect/overhead rate is applied to total direct costs on program grants only.
- If leverage funds are included in the proposal, verification is required.
- On-site project reviews will be conducted and include a review of project expenses.

Financial Requirements

- **Financial audits** are required for organizations with an annual operating budget of **\$750,000 or more** (may be considered on a case-by-case basis).
- **Internal financial statements** must be submitted for the most recent year-end.
- A **recent Form 990** is required (KCCF staff utilizes Candid).
