The Urban County Program (UCP) anticipates presenting the FY 2025 Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) Program Subrecipient Agreements for The Salvation Army of McAllen (TSA) and Women Together, Inc. (WT) to Commissioners Court on **July 21, 2026**.

For your review, I have attached the following documents:

- The proposed Subrecipient Agreement for The Salvation Army of McAllen (TSA);
- The proposed Subrecipient Agreement for Women Together, Inc. (WT); and
- The proposed Commissioners Court agenda.

As background, HUD awarded UCP the FY 2025 ESG funding through the Initial Federal Award Agreement on **September 25, 2025 (please see additional attachment)**. The proposed subrecipient agreements establish a term beginning **November 1, 2025**, and ending **July 31, 2027**.

The requested effective date is intended to allow the subrecipients to seek reimbursement for eligible ESG activities incurred after November 1, 2025. Due to administrative and operational delays within UCP, including staffing transitions, recent hiring, and training, the subrecipients were not provided timely guidance regarding all eligible reimbursable expenses under the

program. As a result, the proposed agreement term is intended to provide them the opportunity to request reimbursement for eligible costs that they have only recently become aware were allowable under the ESG program.
