Minor ground disturbance may occur for installation of the turf field, fencing, bleachers, and shade structures. No land acquisition or expansion beyond the existing park boundaries is proposed.

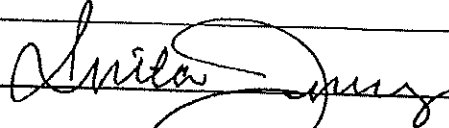
