WHEREAS, it is necessary to appoint person to execute contractual documents and document for requesting funds from the General Land Office; and,

WHEREAS, and original copy of the Depository/Authorized Signatories Designation Form is to be submitted with a copy if this resolution.

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Commissioner's Court designates Hidalgo County Judge and County Executive Officer as the grantee's authorized officials. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Commissioner's Court designates Hidalgo County Auditor and County Treasurer as the grantee's financial officers. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

WHEREAS, Hidalgo County Commissioner's Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Texas General Land Office funds, Hidalgo County Commissioner's Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Texas General Land Office in full.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved that the Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court hereby approves the submission of the FY2026 Local Hazard Mitigation Plan Program application to the Texas General Land Office.

BACKGROUND

Local Hazard Mitigation Plan Program (LHMPP) assists eligible entities by providing grants to develop or update local hazard mitigation plans, or to provide cost share for hazard mitigation planning activities funded through other federal sources. Funds allocated by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and administered by the Texas General Land Office (GLO) to fund updates and the development of the Hazard Mitigation Plan as required by FEMA and implemented through TDEM (Texas Division of Emergency Management).

No fiscal impact at this time, submission of grant application only. No cash match required. A new account will be established upon CC acceptance of the grant award, COR by the County Auditor's Office and appropriation of grant funds.
