The Edinburg High School Red and Blue Sergeanettes
Celebrating Their 90th Anniversary*

Whereas Edinburg High School was the first secondary school drill team established in the Rio Grande Valley; and

Whereas The story of the Edinburg High School Sergeanettes began in 1936 when a young woman, Ms. Kay Teer (Crawford) persuaded the school to establish a pep squad. During that year, the 75 member dance squad took the field for the first time, performing impressive synchronized dancing in front of fans, family and friends; and

Whereas What started as a pep squad to help boost school spirit, evolved into being named the Red and Blue Sergeanettes. For over nine decades, the Red and Blue Sergeanettes have provided stellar performances, amusing thousands of fans over the years with their high-spirited marching, kicking, and dancing; and

Whereas Throughout the years, they have remained committed to improving their dance skills by establishing a tradition of excellence through their commitment, sacrifice, positive attitude, initiative, teamwork, work ethic, enthusiasm, school spirit, academic excellence and personal pride; and

Whereas In the Fall of 2026, the Edinburg High School Sergeanettes took to the field once again, marking the 90 year anniversary of the organization; and

Whereas In March of 2026, the Red and Blue Sergeanettes continued their tradition of excellence by competing on the national stage winning several titles and adding to the countless accolades the organization has earned throughout the years; and

Whereas The Red and Blue Sergeanette Alumni will host a Sundowner Golf Tournament on October 2, 2026 and invite the public to enter a three-man team. In addition to the tournament, the Edinburg Red and Blue Sergeanette Alumni will be in action as they are set to perform at the end of the month with a halftime performance on October 30, 2026 at the Richard R. Flores Stadium in Edinburg, Texas.

Now, therefore, be it proclaimed that the Hidalgo County Commissioners Court hereby congratulates the Edinburg High School Red and Blue Sergeanettes, past and present, for providing 90 years of joy and excitement to thousands of students and spectators across Hidalgo County and beyond.
