**AMENDMENT
TO
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
BY AND BETWEEN RIO GRANDE VALLEY COMMUNICATIONS GROUP and
HIDALGO COUNTY**

This **AMENDMENT** to the **INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT** (as defined below) between **RIO GRANDE VALLEY COMMUNICATIONS GROUP**, hereinafter referred to (the “RGVCG”) and **HIDALGO COUNTY**, hereinafter referred to (the “Hidalgo County”), is effective the **18th** day of **September, 2013**, and is made between the Rio Grande Valley Communications Group and Hidalgo County (the “Amendment”) as follows:

WHEREAS, on or about **October 18, 2011**, **Rio Grande Valley Communications Group** and **Hidalgo County** executed that certain **INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT**, between **Rio Grande Valley Communications Group** and **Hidalgo County**, in which the Rio Grande Valley Communications Group agreed to provide “professional services” for: “**Radio Service**” (the “Interlocal Agreement”);

WHEREAS, due to a change in Section II Duties of RGVCG- A. In General and Section III Duties of Hidalgo County C. Payment of Airtime 4., at the request of Hidalgo County and the Rio Grande Valley Communications have agreed to amend the original Section II Duties of RGVCG- A. In General and Section III Duties of Hidalgo County C. Payment of Airtime 4 for “**Radio Service**” (the “Interlocal Agreement”);

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Agreement as hereinafter provided;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the terms and provisions set forth herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Rio Grande Valley Communications Group and Hidalgo County hereby agree to the amend the Interlocal Agreement as follows:

Section II Duties of RGVCG

A. In General

During the Contract Term, RGVCG shall provide radio air time on and support for the Regional Radio System (RRS) for as many as **2,500** Radio Units. The numbers of units for either primary or back-up dispatch on the Radio System may be increased by mutual written agreement of the RGVCG and Hidalgo County.

Within 30 days of Countersignature, the RGVCG shall program the radio unit(s) according to the initial configuration agreeable to the RGVCG Communications Manager and Hidalgo County. RGVCG may program each radio unit, for a service charge, with the capability to access the Radio System within 30 days after submittal of such Unit to the RGVCG Radio Support Section for programming.

Section III Duties of Hidalgo County


C. Payment of Air Time

4. In the event Hidalgo County requires an increase in the number of radios in excess of 2,500 units authorized in this agreement, a written notification, via regular mail or electronic mail, shall be submitted to RGVCG requesting an increase. The RGVCG will honor all terms and conditions in this agreement for the additional radio units.

Except as modified herein, all terms and conditions of the Interlocal Agreement, as amended by this Amendment, remain in full force and effect and Rio Grande Valley Communications Group and Hidalgo County ratify and confirm the terms and provisions of the Interlocal Agreement, as amended by this Amendment.




