

## RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF THE COUNTY OF HIDALGO, TEXAS, FOR THE DESIGNATION OF THE COORDINATION AND COMPLIANCE OFFICER FOR SECTION 504, EQUAL OPPORTUNITY/FAIR HOUSING AND LABOR STANDARDS FOR ALL PROJECTS UNDERTAKEN BY THE HIDALGO COUNTY URBAN COUNTY PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 requires accessibility for persons with disabilities and prohibits discrimination based on physical handicap; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 11246 Equal Employment Opportunity provides that there shall be no discrimination in employment under federally assisted construction activities; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development continues to enforce the Fair Housing Act, to ensure all Americans have the right to access housing regardless of race, color, sex, religion, national origin, family status or disability; and,

WHEREAS, as predetermined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act to all laborers and mechanics employed in the development of any part of the housing and contracts involving their employment shall be subject to the applicable provisions of the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF THE COUNTY OF HIDALGO, TEXAS:

That Diana R. Serna is hereby appointed as the coordination and compliance officer for the Section 504, Equal Opportunity/Fair Housing and Labor Standards regarding non-discrimination requirements.




