Safe Haven for Kids was created to alleviate the need for local hurting children to be transported to shelters in other cities hours away.

When a child is removed from their home, anywhere in the Rio Grande Valley due to abuse, neglect or abandonment they are transported to the nearest available shelter in Corpus Christi or San Antonio.

We Provide:

A safe loving home environment for abused, neglected or abandoned children from newborn to age 10.

Emergency housing while a more permanent placement is secured by Child Protected Services, either a foster home, family member or a facility.

Their medical, emotional and physical needs, will be met by local health professionals.

Faith-based opportunities will be available to the children.

Recreational outings, music, art and gardening.

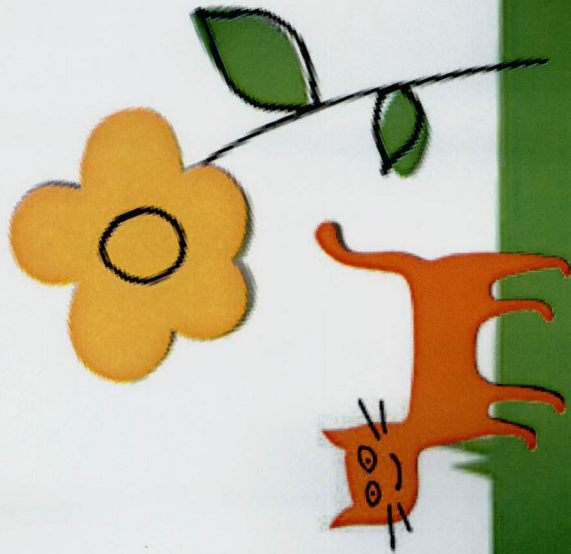

There were 18 deaths in our region and 9 occurred in the Rio Grande Valley.
