



**AN ORDER FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF STREET LIGHTS IN AN UNINCORPORATED AREA OF HIDALGO COUNTY FOR THE CURRY ESTATES PHASE 1 and PHASE 2 SUBDIVISIONS**

**WHEREAS**, Curry Estates Phase 1 and Phase 2 residents live in an unincorporated area of Hidalgo County (County) and do not have adequate street lights; and

**WHEREAS**, the establishment of street lights along County roads located in Curry Estates Phase 1 and Phase 2 would benefit landowners and improve the safety, security, and wellbeing of residents living in Curry Estates Phase 1 and Phase 2, which is characterized by poor infrastructure and higher incidents of crime; and

**WHEREAS**, under section 280.003 of the Texas Transportation Code, the commissioners court of a county that has any of its territory located within 150 miles of an international boundary may establish street lights along a county road located in a subdivision; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 6, 2015, the Hidalgo County Commissioner's Court adopted and approved Rules & Guidelines for the implementation of a Street Lights Program in Hidalgo County;

**NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED** that the Hidalgo County Commissioner's Court does hereby order the establishment of street lights along the county roads located in the Curry Estates Phase 1 and Phase 2 subdivision. The establishment of street lights shall be in accordance with the Hidalgo County Unincorporated Subdivisions Street Lights Program Rules & Guidelines previously established by the Court.
