

## RESOLUTION

### DESIGNATING THE HIDALGO COUNTY JUDGE RAMON GARCIA LAW LIBRARY

**WHEREAS**, Hidalgo County Judge Ramon Garcia has served three terms in office with honor and distinction; and

**WHEREAS**, Judge Garcia worked with Hidalgo County Commissioners, department heads, and staff to strengthen county funds, building up the reserve account from under \$800,000 to more than \$38 million during his tenure and, along with Commissioners Court, operating in a fiscally responsible and efficient manner; and

**WHEREAS**, his leadership in building up the reserves and in fiscal responsibility is the primary reason that the county was able to embark on the construction of a much-needed new Hidalgo County Courthouse; and

**WHEREAS**, as a trailblazer in the initiation to build a new courthouse, along with Judge Garcia's extensive knowledge in law is deserving of recognition by naming the Hidalgo County Law Library in honor of Judge Ramon Garcia; and


**WHEREAS**, Judge Garcia will retire from public office on December 31, 2018 to return to practicing law full-time.


