

RESOLUTION IN HONOR OF 2019 ALL-AMERICA CITY AWARD

WHEREAS, since 1949, the National Civic League has annually recognized and celebrated the best in American civic innovation with a prestigious All-America City Award. This year, the City of Mission, Texas showed how a determined community can tackle tough issues and create real change; and

WHEREAS, a town at the southern tip of Texas, Mission has a little over 83,000 residents, 88% of which are Latino. The town prioritizes civic engagement, partly through the establishment of an All-America Inclusive Committee, which oversees city efforts regarding inclusivity in decision-making. Some of the ways in which residents get involved in community affairs include an annual Wellness Ride cycling event, stocking the city's food pantry, and Mission Pawsible, a foster care program that helps rescue animals and host them for adoption; and


