The undersigned County Judge of Hidalgo County, Texas (the "County") hereby certifies with respect to a plan of finance of the Mission Economic Development Corporation (the "Corporation") including the issuance of one or more series of its Solid Waste Disposal Revenue Bonds (Republic Services, Inc. Project) (the "Bonds"), that:

1. This certificate is based upon the attached Certificate of Public Hearing Officer relating to the public hearing conducted on February 18, 2020 by the duly appointed hearing officer in accordance with the requirements of Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"); and

2. Solely for purposes of the approval requirements of the aforesaid Section 147(f) of the Code, and for no other purposes, in my capacity as County Judge, the chief elected executive office within the County, I hereby approve the plan of finance, including the issuance of the Bonds, in the aggregate maximum stated principal amount of \$480,900,000, and the facilities to be financed and/or refinanced by the plan of finance, including specifically in the County the following facilities: (i) the facility located at 23485 Moorefield Rd, Edinburg, Texas 78541, with the maximum stated principal amount of the Bonds to be used for the portion of the Project at such site of \$23,700,000 and (ii) the facility located at FM 493 & Mile 12 Road East, Donna, Texas 78537, with the maximum stated principal amount of the Bonds to be used for the portion of the Project at such site of \$2,000,000;


**provided, however, THAT THIS APPROVAL IS NOT TO BE CONSTRUED AS (I) A REPRESENTATION OR WARRANTY BY THE COUNTY, THE COUNTY JUDGE OF THE COUNTY, THE STATE OF TEXAS OR ANY OTHER AGENCY, INSTRUMENTALITY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF TEXAS THAT THE BONDS WILL BE PAID OR THAT ANY OBLIGATIONS ASSUMED BY ANY OF THE PARTIES UNDER THE INSTRUMENTS DELIVERED IN CONNECTION WITH THE BONDS WILL IN FACT BE PERFORMED; (II) A PLEDGE OF FAITH AND CREDIT OF THE COUNTY OR THE STATE OF TEXAS OR ANY AGENCY, INSTRUMENTALITY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF TEXAS OR THE COUNTY; OR (III) A REPRESENTATION OR WARRANTY BY THE COUNTY CONCERNING THE VALIDITY OF THE CORPORATE EXISTENCE OF THE CORPORATION OR THE VALIDITY OF THE BONDS.**





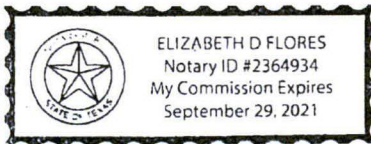
