Second Resolution in support of Texas Senate Bill 594 relating to the provisions of solid waste disposal services by certain counties

- Whereas* the Texas Legislature is considering amending Section 364.011 of the Texas Health and Safety Code regarding the collection of solid waste; and
- Whereas* these amendments govern those counties with a population of more than 700,000 and with two municipalities with a population of more than 77,000 of which Hidalgo County is one; and
- Whereas* the proposed amendment allows for the collection of fees under Section 364.0343 for providing solid waste collection services; and
- Whereas* the proposed amendment allows for the collection of such fees by the county tax assessor-collector which shall be included in a tax bill; and
- Whereas* the proposed amendment allows for the collection of penalties under section 364.0345 in the amount reasonable and necessary for failure to use required service; and
- Whereas* the Hidalgo County Commissioners Court unanimously agrees that the penalty may not exceed 10% per year

Now therefore, be it resolved That the Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court continues to support Senate Bill 594 and urges the Texas Legislature to pass this bill into law and for the Governor of Texas to sign it into law.


