#### **II. TERM OR AGREEMENT**

The term of this agreement is for two years, it will begin on October 16, 2021, and end on October 21, 2023, unless sooner terminated by mutual agreement of the parties.

COUNTY will receive no reimbursement from DHR for any services provided under the agreement. DHR will receive no reimbursement from COUNTY for any services provided as described herein.

**VII. LAW GOVERNING VENUE**


