**AN ORDER FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF STREET LIGHTS IN AN UNINCORPORATED AREA OF HIDALGO COUNTY FOR THE SAN CARLOS HOMESITES SUBDIVISION**

**WHEREAS**, San Carlos Homesites Subdivision residents live in an unincorporated area of Hidalgo County (County) and do not have adequate street lights; and

**WHEREAS**, the establishment of street lights along County roads located in San Carlos Homesites would benefit landowners and improve the safety, security, and wellbeing of residents living in San Carlos Homesites, which is characterized by poor infrastructure and higher incidents of crime; and

**WHEREAS**, under section 280.003 of the Texas Transportation Code, the commissioners court of a county that has any of its territory located within 150 miles of an international boundary may establish street lights along a county road located in a subdivision; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 6, 2015, the Hidalgo County Commissioner's Court adopted and approved Rules & Guidelines for the implementation of a Street Lights Program in Hidalgo County;

**NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED** that the Hidalgo County Commissioner's Court does hereby order the establishment of street lights along the county roads located in the San Carlos Homesites subdivision. The establishment of street lights shall be in accordance with the Hidalgo County Unincorporated Subdivisions Street Lights Program Rules & Guidelines previously established by the Court.
