Throughout this career, she was offered E-Comm/Print model jobs for bridal and prom dresses, boutique clothing, and footwear. Her ambition is to own a marketing firm focusing on the beauty industry; and

Whereas with love and encouragement from family and friends, Victoria has learned to stay true to herself; and

Whereas it is because of her early college experience that she felt the need to do more to help fight discrimination. She believes that culture and diversity training shouldn't start in college or at an orientation for new employment, but during childhood. Victoria believes in focusing on future generations at an earlier age by advocating for the importance of appreciating and respecting different cultures, religions, and traditions.
