



**Acknowledgment of Obligations for
2022 "Road to Recycling" Regional Tire Collection Project
Saturday, May 28, 2022**

The Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council (LRGVDC) held its annual "Road to Recycling" Tire Collection Event on Saturday, May 28, 2022. The LRGVDC will continue the same process as has been conducted for the past "Road to Recycling" events and reimburse only for disposal fees. This project is funded through LRGVDC and TCEQ, therefore, we ask that this acknowledgment form be signed and dated by an authorized representative, acknowledging the responsibilities and payment of the LRGVDC and the participating entity.

For the 2022 event, LRGVDC provided the option for entities to use a vendor they currently have a contract with or to use their container(s) and transport it to a tire disposal facility. This option was for the entity to save on costs for this event and to utilize their contracts, rather than having to choose from our only two options, Republic Services, and Brownsville Landfill. For the LRGVDC to pay the disposal fees, the entity must provide invoices and manifests. These documents will be reviewed and approved as records for payment.
