Project Description	The project consists of the construction of a seven-story courthouse building. The building structure consists of a drilled-pier, grade-beam, and slab-on-grade foundation system with structural steel interior and roof system. Site work includes utilities, associated 2-story parking garage, parking lot and drives. Pavements consists of concrete.

2.0 Scope of Services

Terracon is providing materials testing and special inspection services as summarized below:

Item	Description
Over excavation & Backfill Observation	During over-excavation operations, observations of the excavated material stockpiles and the condition of soils found at the bottom of the excavations were performed. We observed moisture conditioning and backfill operations, and perform moisture/density tests on the backfill materials.
Earthwork	Terracon obtained samples for laboratory tests, performed in-place field density testing and performed periodic or full-time observations for underground utility trench backfill, foundation backfill, slab subgrade, flatwork subgrade, and pavement subgrade preparation.
Foundation Excavation Observation	During footing excavation, observations were performed to observe soil conditions at the base of the excavations.
Concrete Formwork and Reinforcing Steel	<p>Prior to concrete placement, formwork and reinforcing steel for spread footings, slabs-on-grade, and other structural elements were observed by Terracon. The concrete was sampled and tested for slump, air content, unit weight, and temperature at the time of placement. Cylinders were made and initially cured on site. 


