## Resolution & Order Pertaining to Naming Jorge D. Hinojosa Field Operations Facility

- Whereas* Mr. Jorge D. Hinojosa, also known as "B", was the former Hidalgo County Precinct 2 Director of Field Operations. He was born on October 6, 1979 in Rio Grande City and entered eternal rest on January 2, 2023; and
- Whereas* Mr. Hinojosa is survived by his wife, Alissa Hinojosa; 4 year-old twin sons, Fernando Daniel & Fidel David; 3 year-old daughter Alexandria Iliana; Father, Fidel Hinojosa; Mother, Eliahever Hinojosa; three brothers and one sister; and
- Whereas* Jorge Hinojosa graduated from Roma High School in 1998, where he was an active athlete and participated in basketball, football, tennis and soccer; and
- Whereas* Many knew Jorge by his infectious smile, his positive attitude and his caring nature. He was known to be "the guy that would take the shirt off his back for anyone;" and
- Whereas* Mr. Hinojosa's tenure began under Commissioner Eduardo "Eddie" Cantu's first term on January 1, 2015 and he had recently completed eight years of service to the county; and
- Whereas* Mr. Hinojosa supervised 57 employees at the Precinct 2 Field Operations Facility and the Hidalgo County Countywide Mechanic Shop; and was instrumental in working with other department heads in disaster events such as hurricanes, rain events, and most recently the COVID-19 pandemic; and
- Whereas* The Precinct 2 Field Operations Facility is located at 4011 S Veterans Blvd in San Juan, TX; and
- Whereas* the County of Hidalgo wishes to rename the Precinct 2 Field Operations Facility in memory and honor of Jorge D. Hinojosa for his dedicated service to the community and employees of Precinct 2.

*Now, therefore, be it resolved* that the Hidalgo County Commissioners Court hereby renames the Hidalgo County Precinct 2 Field Operations Facility to the Hidalgo County Precinct 2 Jorge D. Hinojosa Field Operations Facility. The Commissioners Court authorizes the County to execute the appropriate documents approving this name change. This Resolution and Order shall take effect immediately from and after it is passed and is duly resolved and ordered.
