SIGNATURE IDENTIFICATION AND NO-LITIGATION CERTIFICATE

We, the undersigned officers of the County of Hidalgo, Texas (the "County"), acting solely in our official capacities, certify that we executed, by our manual or facsimile signatures, on behalf of said County, the following described obligations, hereinafter called the "Certificates", to-wit:

HIDALGO COUNTY, TEXAS CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION, SERIES 2023, dated September 15, 2023, in the aggregate principal amount of \$43,440,000.

We further certify as follows:

1. That the Certificates have been duly and officially executed by the undersigned with their manual or facsimile signatures in the same manner appearing hereon, and the undersigned hereby adopt and ratify their respective signatures in the manner appearing on each of the Certificates as their own signatures.

2. That on the date of such execution and on the date hereof, we were and are the duly chosen, qualified, and acting officers of the County authorized to execute the same.

3. That no litigation of any nature is now pending or, to the best of our knowledge, threatened, either in the state or federal courts, contesting or attacking the existence of the County, the boundaries of the County, or the Certificates or restraining or enjoining the issuance, execution, or delivery of the Certificates or the collection or pledge of the funds from which the Certificates are payable, or in any manner questioning the authority or proceedings for the issuance, execution, or delivery of the Certificates, or affecting the titles of the present officials of the County, and that no proceedings or authority for the issuance, execution, or delivery of the Certificates have been repealed, rescinded or revoked.

4. That no litigation of any nature is now pending or, to the best of our knowledge, threatened, either in state or federal courts, that would affect the authority for the issuance of the Certificates or the assessment or collection of taxes pledged to pay the principal of and interest on the Certificates.

5. That the seal which has been impressed, or placed in facsimile, upon the Certificates is the legally adopted, proper and only official seal of the County, said official seal being impressed on this certificate.

6. That all the proceedings for the issuance of the Certificates as adopted by the officers of the County have not been amended, repealed, or rescinded since the date of their passage, and all such proceeding relating to the issuance of the Certificates remain in full force and effect as of the date of this certificate.

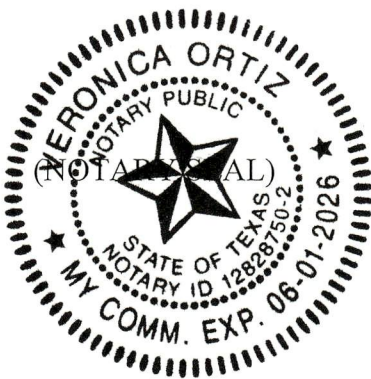
