1. Parks Manager Update

- a. Community Park playground has been ordered on 02/16.
- b. Wheelchair Swing will not be installed at this time as Mr. King is applying for a grant thru the Christopher Reeves Foundation to cover \$25,000 of the cost. When the wheelchair swing is ordered, it will be the 5th in the state of Ohio.
- c. Eichelberger Amphitheater playground has been ordered. The playground will have AstroTurf under it and pad work will begin in the next several weeks pending weather.
- d. Product has been ordered for the planting of the pollinator meadows at Rip Rap Park (7 acres) and Cloud Park (3 acres).
- e. Quote for the asphalt pad for basketball courts at Eichelberger Amphitheater came in over \$60,000, so it will be going out to bid. The project will be completed either in 2022 or 2023 depending on funding.
- f. Music series has 6 confirmed concerts and Mr. King is working on the last several confirmations for the season. The first weekend of the month will have a bigger name band to draw more people.
- q. Farmer's Market will open on May 7th.
- h. Mr. King is working on a grant with CultureWorks for a grant opportunity at the community center for a Lego camp in 2023.
