- 2001 52 funded fire positions
- 2009 51 funded fire personnel
- 2011 48 funded fire personnel
- 2016 51 funded fire personnel
- 2019 54 funded fire personnel
- 2022 54 funded fire personnel
 - 1 Fire Chief
 - 4 Battalion Chiefs
 - 10 Lieutenants
 - 39 Firefighter / Paramedics










Service Demand 2009-2021









CALL DEMAND BY STATION 2021










Historic Call Demand by Station






Fire/EMS personnel per 1,000 population / Call Demand per authorized staff






COST PER CALL CALLS PER AUTHORIZED STAFF
